



# 2018 Vocabulary Building Course for the College-bound

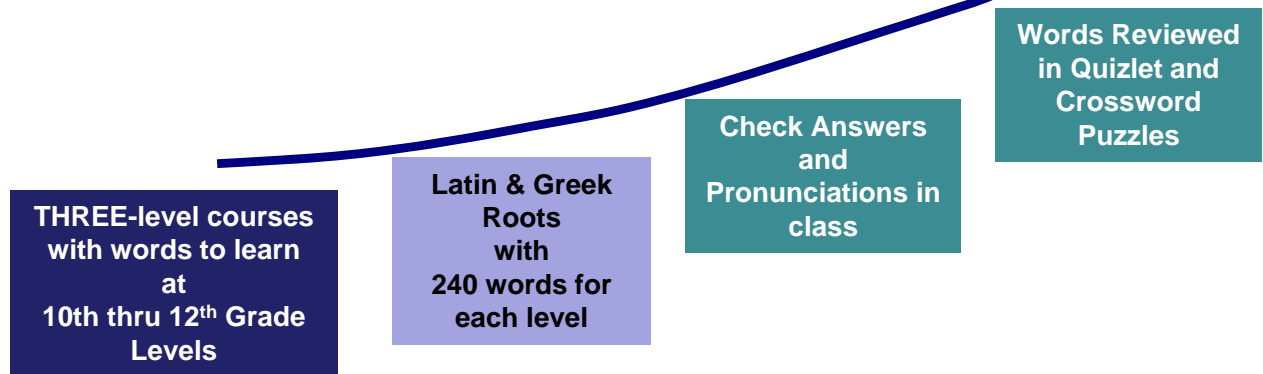

First of all, a lesson goes fast! Students must prepare for 3 units in each lesson before attending class. In class, the teacher will pronounce targeted words and present the answer key of ONE unit in 30 min. After class, students are to review the words and answers and also to tackle exercises in Quizlet at home. The 8 lessons will cover a textbook which contains approx. 240 words to memorize. No make-up lessons for absentee students.

# 海外大学向け ボキャブラリー・ビルディングコース

SAT®/ACT®テストのreading sectionでハイスコアを取るのにボキャブラリー増強が不可欠です。このコースではギリシャ語・ラテン語の語根の知識を増やしなが、SAT®/ACT®テストで必須のボキャブラリーを暗記することを目標に授業を進めます。そのため授業は予習前提とし、30分で1UNIT終了するペースで、毎回3UNITSのハイペースで進めていきます。授業時間では答合わせが中心になりますが、講師の発音に注意しつつ、授業中にボキャブラリーを暗記する気持ちで臨んでください。授業後にも復習を欠かさず、自宅のパソコン等でQuizletにアクセスし確認問題に取り組んでください。1レベル1冊のテキストを全8回(8 Lessons)で終了させ、約240語を覚えていきます。(Quizlet内でも発音チェックできます。)

授業は英語のみで、講師は日本語を解しませんが、日本の高校に通学されていて米国や海外の大学に進学するためにSAT®受験準備中の方も受講可能です。また、英検1級レベルの語彙も出てきますので、日本の大学受験 英単語上級レベルを習得済みの方にお勧めできます。

なお、テキストには解答冊子は存在しません。また、欠席者には振替授業は用意できませんので予めご了承ください。
